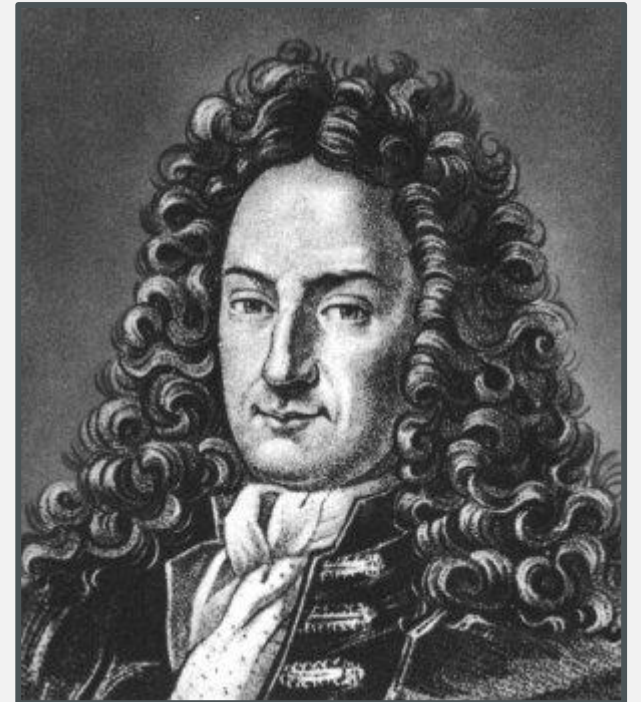

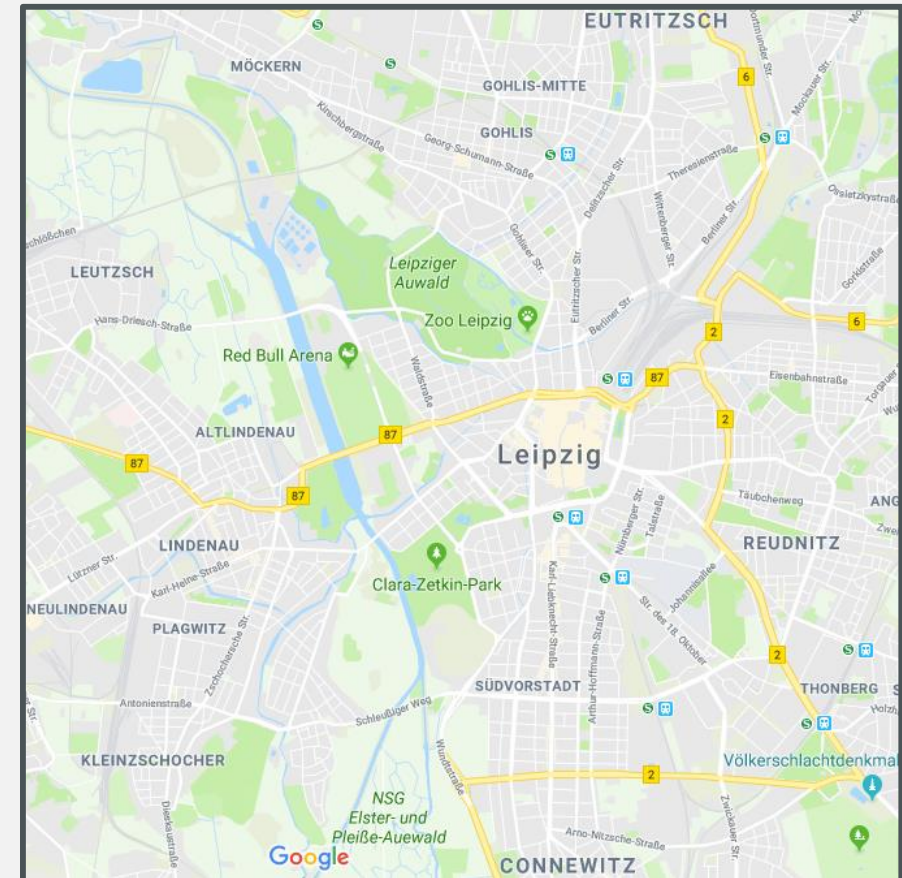
SOME FACTS

- Home of Johann Sebastian Bach and Gottfried Leibniz
- Origin of the first printed European newspaper
- Up and coming city (“the new Berlin”)
- Relatively cheap
 - Beer (0.5L): 3.00 euros
 - Mid-range restaurant: 10-20 euros per person



GENERAL INFORMATION

- **When?** 23-25 March

 - Registration through online form on NFK website (starting 15th of January, at noon)



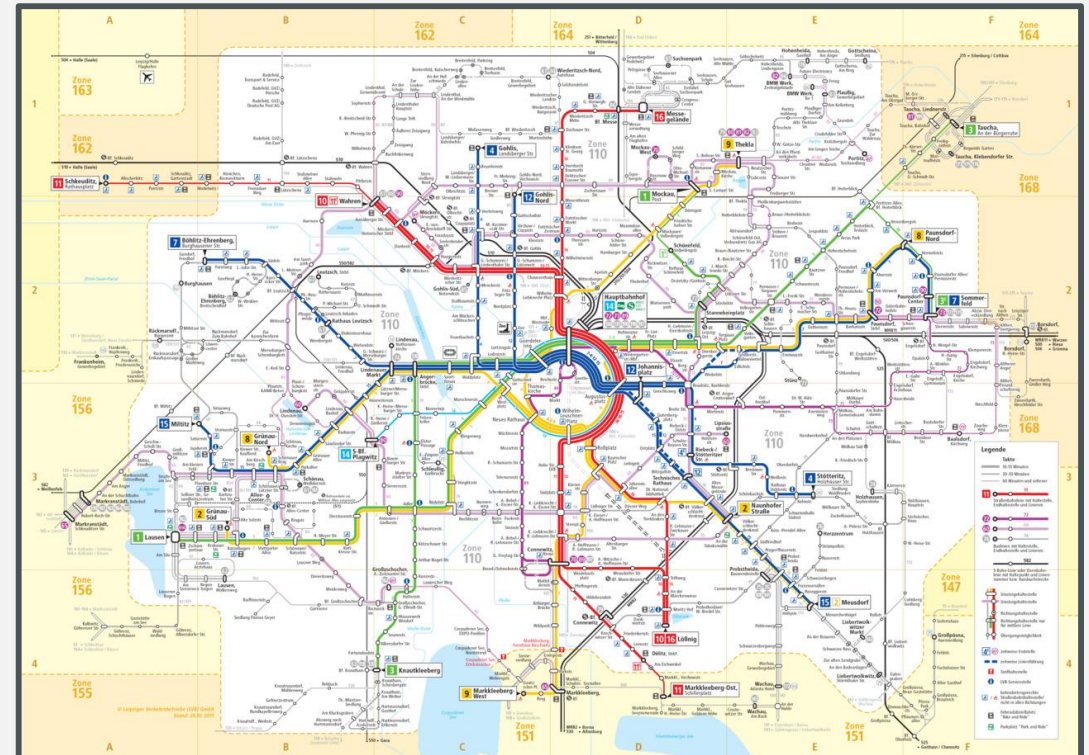
ACCOMODATION: MEININGER HOSTEL

 - Day ticket: 7.00 euros
- Taxi
 - App. 1.75 euros p/km
- NFK will offer some opt-in pre-bought tram tickets
